The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'the Cr.P.C.') seeking regular bail in case FIR No.20, dated 05.02.2018, registered under Sections 147, 149, 323, 506, 404, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Radaur, District Yamuna Nagar.

2. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits *inter alia* that the Civil Suit filed by the petitioner was long before the death of Harbans Kaur, and that he places no reliance whatsoever on any Will or document as alleged in the original FIR. The petitioner has remained in detention since 07.01.2020.

3. Considering the overall circumstances, further detention, at this stage, would not serve any purpose. Therefore, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner, namely, Rupinder Singh @ Dulla, is ordered to

be released on regular bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
