The petitioner has approached this Court seeking quashing of impugned order dated 14.8.2018 (Annexure P-2) passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Nakodar.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court does not find any justifiable ground to interfere with impugned order dated 14.8.2018. The petition, as such is dismissed.

However, in case the petitioner chooses to surrender before the trial Court within a period of 10 days from today and applies for grant of regular bail, the learned trial Court shall endeavour to dispose of the same expeditiously, preferably within a period of one week from filing of such application.
