The instant Petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking Regular Bail in case FIR No.0360, dated 28.10.2019, registered under Section 17 of the ND&PS Act No.61 of 1985, at Police Station Civil Line Sirsa, District Sirsa.

2. The Petitioner has remained in detention since 28th October, 2019.

3. The contraband allegedly recovered from the Petitioner, is well below the commercial quantity.

4. There is no record of his involvement in any other case under the NDPS Act.

5 For the aforesaid reasons, the present Petition is allowed and the Petitioner, namely, Rameshwar is ordered to be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court concerned.
