This matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to Covid-19 Pandemic.

This is the first petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 262 dated 08.10.2019, under Sections 22, 29 of NDPS Act, 1985 (Act No.61 of 1985) registered at Police Station Lehra, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has referred to the wedding invitation card, which he has placed on the record and submitted that marriage of the petitioner is fixed on 04.08.2020 and 05.08.2020. He prays that the petitioner may be granted interim bail for one week for his marriage. According to the counsel, petitioner was lodged in District Jail, Sangrur, but has now been shifted to District Jail, Nabha.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Pawan Sharda, Senior DAG, Punjab, who is present through video conferencing, has sought

instructions from SI Harmeet Singh. He has informed the Court that factum and date of marriage of the petitioner has been verified and found to be correct. The IO has recorded the statement of Joginder Singh, Sarpanch and other respectables from village Haraya, District Sangrur, who are willing to take responsibility of the petitioner, in case, he is released on bail.

State counsel has, however, opposed the prayer on the ground that exceptionally huge quantity of contraband (24,500 tablets of Clovidol and 29000 tablets of Alprazolam) have been recovered from the petitioner and there are two other cases under the NDPS Act against the petitioner.

I have considered the rival submissions.

Keeping in view the fact that the factum of marriage of the petitioner has been verified and the respectables of the village are also ready to take his responsibility, it is fit and proper that the petitioner be granted interim bail for four days for his marriage, which is scheduled on 04.08.2020 and 05.08.2020. It is accordingly, directed that the petitioner be taken for his marriage in proper police custody as per police Rules and he be brought back to District Jail, Nabha on 07.08.2020 by 6:00 p.m. The Superintendent, District Jail, Nabha is directed to make necessary arrangements in this regard.

Petition stands disposed of.
