Petitioners have filed this petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos.4 to 7 as they have married against the wishes of the private respondents.

On 24.01.2020, learned State counsel was directed to find out the existence of alleged threat. In response to the said order, reply by way of affidavit of Chander Pal, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Jind on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 has been filed in Court today. Along with the reply, statements of the petitioners have been appended as Annexures R-1 and R-2, wherein they have stated that they do not have any threat and are residing peacefully. It has also been stated by both of them that they do not want any police protection.

In view of the above, nothing survives for adjudication in this petition, which is rendered infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.
