ARUN PALLI, J. (Oral)

The petitioners, who claim to be major, allege to have married each other against wishes of respondents No. 4 to 6, who happened to be the parents/family members of petitioner No.1 (Karamjit Kaur). In the circumstances, they apprehend danger to their lives and their implication as also of the family members of petitioner No.2 in a false case.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that representation moved by the petitioner, dated 21.01.2020 (Annexure P-5), seeking protection and other suitable measures, is pending consideration before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala, District Patiala (respondent No.2), but to no avail.

In the wake of the above, and without commenting upon the veracity of the allegations set out in the petition as also the validity of the marriage of the petitioners, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala, District Patiala (respondent No.2)

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that, if any such representation, as indicated above, is pending, the same shall be considered forthwith and appropriate measures, as deemed necessary, shall be taken.

The petition stands disposed of, accordingly.

A copy of this order be sent to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala, District Patiala (respondent No.2), so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
