This petition has been filed by the petitioner being aggrieved by an order dated 13.11.2019 terminating the contract agreement entered between the parties in exercise of powers contained under clause 56.1 and other terms of the Contract.

Apparently and undisputedly, the petitioner has to resort to the disputes resolution mechanism contained in clause 25 of the terms of contract (Annexure P/21), whereas the petitioner, without resorting to such measures, has approached this Court. Further, the issue involved requires adjudication on several disputed questions of fact and as there exists a dispute resolution clause, we do not find any reason to entertain this petition, at this stage.

Accordingly, the petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to take up all possible issues before the concerned authorities or the Arbitrator, as the case may be, in accordance with law.
