Through this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for quashing of order dated 10.03.2007 of the trial Court, whereby petitioner was declared as proclaimed offender (Annexure P-2) in case FIR No. 54 dated 11.05.2001 registered under Sections 465, 468, 471, 511, 419, 120 IPC and Section 12 of Passport Act.

Relying upon the judgments of this Court in ***Sudo Mandal @ Diwarak Mandal Versus State of Punjab, 2011 (2) RCR (Criminal) 453; Mehar Singh and another Versus State of Punjab, 2010(2) RCR (Criminal) 167*** and ***Jasvinder Singh Versus State of Punjab and another, 2013 (1) RCR (Criminal) 310***, learned counsel contends that petitioner was declared proclaimed offender in his absence.

Heard.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, petitioner is relegated to the trial Court and directed to surrender before it, within a

week from today, with liberty to raise all the pleas, which have been taken in this petition. On doing so, his bail application, if any, shall be decided expeditiously on merits in accordance with law.

The instant petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
