Through instant 1st petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.0274 dated 01.11.2019 under Section 22 of the Narcotics Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Lehra, District Sangrur.

According to the prosecution, on 01.11.2019, 450 tablets make Clovidol-100 SR, prohibited drug contained in plastic bag were recovered from Gurpreet Singh, petitioner No.2 and 500 tablets make Clovidol-100 SR were recovered from Bahadar Singh petitioner No.1 without any permit or licence.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that FSL report has not yet been received. Therefore, it cannot be said at this stage that alleged recovery was a narcotic substance. Petitioners are in custody since 01.11.2019.

In view of above, but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petitioners are granted interim bail subject to

furnishing personal bonds and two sureties of ₹ 2.00 lakh each, to the satisfaction of Special Court concerned only till receipt of the FSL report.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
