Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to the respondents No.3 and 4 not to unnecessarily harass the petitioners on account of false and frivolous complaints filed by respondent No.5.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that despite the matter having been compromised between the parties vide compromise dated 27.04.2019 (Annexure P-1), wherein the respondent No.5 is also signatory, on the asking of respondent No.5, the police is still summoning the petitioners on one count or the other. The petitioners have already submitted an application dated 22.11.2019 (Annexure P-3) to respondent No.2 Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur, but no action has been taken by the police.

Without observing anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the contents of application (Annexure P-3) and to act in accordance with law.
