Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through this petition, the petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.153 dated 09.06.2018, registered at Police Station Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran, under Sections 420, 468, 471, 209, 120-B, 447, 511, 427, 506, 148 and 149 IPC, alongwith all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 17.12.2019 (Annexure P-2), arrived at between the parties.

Vide order dated 07.10.2020 passed by this Court, the Area Magistrate was directed to record the statements of the parties with regard to the genuineness and authenticity of the compromise.

In compliance thereof, the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Tarn Taran, has submitted a report vide letter dated 16.10.2020 to the effect that no opinion regarding genuineness of the

compromise between the parties could be given as petitioners No.1 to 3 had absented themselves and not turned up for getting their statements recorded, and that in absence of statements of petitioners No.1 to 3, the compromise could not be said to have been genuine.

Despite the second opportunity granted by this Court vide order dated 07.10.2020, the parties have failed to get their statements recorded before the Area Magistrate.

Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioners wants to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
