[1] Prayer in the writ petition is for the issuance of a writ of mandamus to direct the respondents to regularize the services of the petitioner as per Government Policy (Annexure P-1) dated 29.07.2011 as circulated vide order (Annexure P-2) dated 03.08.2011 or in the alternative to direct the respondents to take a final decision on the claim of the petitioner on the basis of legal notice (Annexure P-5) dated 09.09.2019, within a time bound manner.

[2] Without commenting upon the merits of the claim or the entitlement of the petitioner to the relief claimed, the writ petition is ***disposed of*** by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the claim of the petitioner, in accordance with law after taking into account all aspects of the matter including judgments relied upon by the petitioner i.e. Annexures P-6 to P-8, in case the same are applicable, within 03 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
