The petitioner prays for grant of bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No.65 dated 11.7.2019 registered under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Sadar Nawanshahr, District SBS Nagar.

As per the case of the prosecution, the petitioner was apprehended with 12 injections each of Buprenorphin Hydrochloride and Avil.

Learned State counsel has pointed out that previously the petitioner was convicted under the NDPS Act, 1985, in FIR no. 232 dated 29.8.2013 vide judgment dated 13.2.2014 passed by Additional Sessions Judge, Jalandhar.

In view thereof, there is no ground to grant the concession of bail to the petitioner, particularly, when the recovery in the present case also falls in the category of commercial quantity.

Hence, dismissed.
