The instant Petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking Regular Bail in case FIR No.0147, dated 06.09.2019, registered under Section 20 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short, 'the NDPS Act'), at Police Station Kalka, District Panchkula.

2. Heard.

3. The Petitioner has remained in detention for more than 05 months since 6th September, 2019.

4. Challan already submitted after completion of investigation.

5. Recovery of the contraband from the Petitioner was slightly above the small quantity.

6. He is reported to be involved in two other cases under the NDPS Act but has already been released on bail by the concerned Courts.

7. Considering the long detention and the overall circumstance, the present Petition is allowed and the Petitioner, namely, Sonu @ Jai Mata, is ordered to be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court concerned.
