The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.42 dated 19.01.2018 registered under Sections 148, 149, 302, 506, 216, 120-B IPC at Police Station Samalkha, District Panipat.

On 29.01.2020, the following order was passed:

“Counsel for the petitioner has argued that during the course of investigation, the petitioner was found innocent and was kept in Column No.2 while submitting the report under Section 173 Cr.P.C., however, the petitioner has been summoned as an additional accused while allowing the application under Section 319 Cr.P.C. It is further submitted that the petitioner is ready to face the trial and do not intend to challenge the order dated 01.10.2019 vide which the petitioner was summoned as an additional accused.

Notice of motion.

Mr. A.P.S. Gill, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on

behalf of the respondent while Mr. K.D. Sehra, Advocate has appeared on behalf of the complainant.

Counsel for the petitioner is directed to supply a complete copy of paperbook to counsel opposite, during the course of the day.

List again on 06.03.2020.

In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court within a period of 10 days from today and the trial Court will release the petitioner on interim bail subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 29.01.2020, has already appeared before the trial Court and he has been released on interim bail.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Jitender, assisted by learned counsel for the complainant, has not disputed the aforesaid fact.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and order dated 29.01.2020 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
