The petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 193 dated 29.11.2019, registered under Section 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the IPC at Police Station Fazilka, District Fazilka.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that as per the allegations in the FIR, it is stated that petitioners, by impersonating some person as Indro Bai, who has died on 10.03.2001, has got transferred 06 Kanals of land of Indro Bai in their favour.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the land already stands reverted in the name of Indro Bai, vide sale deed dated 19.03.2019 bearing Wasika No. 2955.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Bhagwan Singh, submits that the accused persons have again committed a forgery while executing sale deed dated 19.03.2019 by producing some other person

as Indro Bai, who in fact had died on 10.03.2001, and they have tried to mislead the Court in this manner.

Learned counsel for the complainant as well as learned State counsel brought to the notice of this Court the order dated 20.01.2020 passed in CRM-M-1439-2020, wherein noticing the fact that land of Indro Bai was reverted back to original owner, co-accused Gurdev Singh and Gurmeet Singh were granted concession of interim anticipatory bail, however, the fact that Indro Bai had died on 10.03.2001 was not brought to the notice of the Court.

Considering the allegations in the FIR, as per which, the petitioners along with other accused, in conspiracy with each other, by impersonating some one as Indro Bai, have got the land of Indro Bai transferred in favour of the petitioners and thereafter by setting up a sale deed dated 19.03.2019, again by impersonating some one as Indro Bai, they have stated before this Court as noticed above that the land in dispute stands reverted back in the name of Indro Bai, who had in fact died on 10.03.2001, this Court finds no ground to grant them concession of anticipatory bail.

Accordingly, this petition is hereby dismissed.
