Challenge in the present writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is to the order dated 05.07.2006 (Annexure P-1) whereby the petitioner's services were terminated who was working as a Conductor, by the respondent No.2-Director State Transport.

The said order was challenged before the Civil Court by way of filing Civil Suit, which was dismissed on 28.07.2011 (Annexure P-6). The matter was, thereafter, taken in appeal to the Appellate Court and the appeal was dismissed on 26.04.2012 (Annexure P-7). The regular second appeal bearing RSA No.3726 of 2012 was dismissed on 28.03.2016 (Annexure P-8).

Once the petitioner has exhausted all his legal remedies, the present writ petition challenging the said order is not maintainable, as the petitioner cannot be allowed to change tracks. Accordingly, there is no merit in the present writ petition and the same is dismissed in limine.
