Petitioners have filed this petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty and also directing respondent Nos.4 to 8 not to interfere in their peaceful life.

On 27.01.2020, learned State counsel was directed to find out the existence of alleged threat. In response to the said order, status report by way of affidavit of Jagat Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Narwana, District Jind on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 has been filed in Court today. As per this reply, it is mentioned that during enquiry, the petitioners were not found residing at Village Dablain. Their whereabouts are also not known. The statement of respondent No.4-father of petitioner No.1 (Annexure R-1) was recorded, wherein he has stated that they have no objection to the marriage between the petitioners and further that they will not cause any loss of life or property to them, as they are happy with the marriage.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners does not press petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.
