Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 223 dated 02.08.2019 registered under Section 380 IPC, at Police Station Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that after bare reading of the FIR, no case is made out against the petitioners rather the petitioners were falsely implicated in the present case. He further states that as per the story of the prosecution, the petitioners were trying to commit theft.

Heard.

There are specific allegations that the incident of theft has been videographed by Umesh Kumar, Security Manager and caught them red handed but they fled away from the spot.

Learned Sessions Judge, Sangrur, while dismissing the bail of the accused-petitioners has also taken into consideration the video clip, screen shots and compact disk and I am agree with the observations made therein.

In view of the above, no ground is made to allow the prayer of the petitioners.

Present petition is dismissed accordingly.
