Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to the respondents No.2 and 3 not to harass the petitioner at the behest of respondents No.4 to 6 and to decide the representation dated 7.8.2019 (Annexure P.3).

Learned State counsel, on telephonic instructions from SHO, Police Station 'B' Division, Amritsar, District Amritsar, i.e. respondent No.3 has submitted that the enquiry was conducted on the representation of the petitioner which was found to be without any basis and no cognizable offence was made out, the same was filed.

It is further submitted that during the enquiry respondent No.4- Gurmukh Singh committed suicide and in this regard FIR No.179 dated 4.12.2019 under Sections 306, 34 IPC is registered against the accused persons in Police Station 'E' Division, Amritsar and the investigation is going on.

Learned State counsel has further submitted that the petitioner can approach the Station House Officer, Police Station 'B' Division, Amritsar, District Amritsar again, in case, he see any threat perception at the hands of any other person and appropriate action will be taken, in accordance with law.

The present petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
