Application filed by judgment debtors seeking exemption from the attachment of only residential house under Section 60(1)(ccc) of the Code of Civil Procedure, as added, applicable to the States of Punjab, Haryana and Chandigarh, was dismissed by the learned Executing Court while relying upon judgment passed in **Sheela Rani vs. Punjab and Sind Bank, 1994 (1) Punjab Law Reporter, 583.**

Learned counsels for the parties after arguing at some length have arrived at a consensus. They admit that the aforesaid judgment is not applicable because in the present case the decree for the recovery of amount was passed against the petitioners and not against their predecessors.

Learned counsel for the petitioners relies upon judgment passed in **Saroj Bala and another vs. United Commercial Bank and others, 2013 (26) R.C.R.(Civil), 927.**

Without commenting on merits and keeping in view the facts of the case, it is considered appropriate to request the Executing Court to re-

decide the entire matter in accordance with law.

Disposed of accordingly.
