Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing of criminal complaint No. 97/2015, dated 24.02.2015, registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC passed by the Court of Ms. Supreet Kaur, learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Ludhiana, charge sheet dated 25.09.2019 and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise deed dated 10.12.2019 (Annexure P-5) effected in between the parties.

Pursuant to orders dated 28.01.2020 of this Court, the parties appeared before Ld. JMIC, Ludhiana, on 28.02.2020 to get their statements recorded. Learned JMIC, Ludhiana submitted her report vide letter No. 47 dated 28.02.2020 duly forwarded by the learned District and Sessions

Judge, Ludhiana, vide letter No. 159 dated 28.02.2020.

According to the report, learned JMIC, Ludhiana, is satisfied that compromise effected between the parties is genuine one, without any pressure or out of their own will.

In compliance of order dated 28.01.2020, original receipts regarding deposit of costs of Rs. 20,000/- have also been produced in Court today. The same are taken on record. Be tagged at appropriate place.

Considering the report of JMIC, Ludhiana, dated 28.02.2020 and deposit of costs as well as the fact that the compromise will bring peace and harmony between the parties, aforesaid criminal complaint No. 97/2015 dated 24.02.2015 (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are quashed, qua the petitioners only.

Registry is directed to verify deposit of aforesaid costs, with the concerned quarter.

Disposed of, accordingly.
