The petitioner prays for grant of regular bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No.154 dated 10.10.2019 registered under Section 379-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Shimlapuri, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

As per the case of the prosecution, first informant-Asha got registered the present FIR while asserting that on 09.09.2019 at about 12:30 PM, one unknown person came on a motorcycle (black colour) and snatched her gold earring of the left ear forcibly while threatening to cause injuries with a weapon. The petitioner is in custody since 14.10.2019. Investigations in the present case have been concluded. Final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has been filed.

Learned counsel for the State submits that the petitioner is

involved in four more criminal cases. On the other hand, learned counsel for the petitioner while drawing attention of the Court to the judgments dated 08.10.2015, 22.08.2017 and 01.11.2016, has submitted that the petitioner has been acquitted in FIR No.69, as well as in FIR No.80. Whereas in FIR No.82 registered under the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, the petitioner was convicted and sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for a period of 8 months. He further submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in two more cases on 10.11.2019, including the present case.

This Court has considered the submissions. The petitioner is involved in large number of cases. He has also been convicted under the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act vide judgment dated 22.08.2017.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, this Court is not inclined to grant concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
