Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 138 dated 24.05.2019 registered under Sections 304-B, 323 and 34 IPC, at Police Station Sadar Gohana, District Sonipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has been in custody since 25.05.2019. He is brother-in-law(Devar) of the deceased and was residing separately alongwith his wife, who has been granted regular bail by the Coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 26.11.2019 passed in CRM-M-49451-2019. He further argues that neither there is specific allegation against the petitioner nor any complaint was moved against him earlier.

Learned State counsel points out that challan has been presented, charges have been framed and out of 19 prosecution witnesses, 10 witnesses have been examined. He also states that on 04.02.2020, father of the deceased stepped into the witness-box and stated that he used to visit the house of his daughter, who was happily residing with her family. Petitioner-Ravinder is younger brother of Sandeep, husband of the deceased, who is in custody.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and gone through the record.

Challan has been presented and the charges have been framed. The petitioner has been in custody since 25.05.2019. The trial of the case would take time to conclude. No useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bars.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits, lest it should prejudice the case of either side, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
