Custody certificate of the petitioner has been filed by the learned State counsel in Court today, which is taken on record.

Petitioner is seeking regular bail with regard to the case registered vide FIR bearing No. 362 dated 20.08.2010 at Police Station Civil Lines, Amritsar, District Amritsar City under Sections 379/411/472 IPC, 1860. The allegations against the petitioner are with regard to the theft of a motorcycle. He was declared proclaimed offender vide order dated 08.06.2015.

It has been stated by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner had been regularly appearing in the trial Court and on one date he could not put appearance as he was out of town and subsequently, there was miscommunication with regard to the date of hearing, consequently he was declared proclaimed offender.

As per custody certificate the petitioner has undergone an actual sentence of imprisonment for a period of 10 months and 22 days. He has

As such, sufficient grounds are made out to extend the concession of bail to the petitioner.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing requisite bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
