Petitioners have filed this petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to the official respondents to protect their life and liberty from the hands of private respondents.

On 30.01.2020, learned State counsel was directed to find out the existence of alleged threat. In response to the said order, reply by way of affidavit of Surinder Singh, HPC, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Shahabad (M) on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 has been filed in Court today. Along with the reply, statements of the petitioners as well as respondent Nos.4 and 5 have been appended as Annexures R-1 to R-4. The petitioners have stated that they do not have any danger from any person and they are living peacefully. Respondent Nos.4 and 5 have also stated that they will not cause any loss to the petitioners.

In view of the above, nothing survives for adjudication in this petition, which is rendered infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.
