Petitioners have filed this petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty from the hands of respondent Nos.4 and 5 and not to interfere in their peaceful life.

On 29.01.2020, learned State counsel was directed to find out the existence of alleged threat. In response to the said order, learned State counsel has produced photocopies of statements of the petitioners and father of petitioner No.1 recorded by the police, wherein petitioners have stated that they do not have any threat as on today. Respondent No.4, in his statement, has expressed no objection to the marriage between the petitioners.

In view of the above, nothing survives for adjudication in this petition, which is rendered infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.
