Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.463 dated 18.10.2019, registered under Sections 148/149/323/325/285/506/458 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act at Police Station Civil Lines, Kaithal.

As per prosecution case in the intervening night of 17/18th October 2019, at about 12.30 a.m., some persons knocked the door of the complainant and did firing. They entered into the house and caused injuries to the wife and mother of the complainant. They brought out the victims out of the house and then caused beatings to the complainant and his family members. Petitioner was armed with a toy pistol. In the

firing done by the other accused, none was injured. The injuries received by the complainant-party attracted offences punishable under Sections 323, 325 IPC. The offences except the offence under Section 458 IPC and 25 of the Arms Act are bailable. Petitioner is in custody since 25.10.2019.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Lajwant Singh submitted that challan has been presented. The charges have not been framed so far.

The complicity of the petitioner would be debatable. The offence is triable by the Magistrate. Trial of the case would take some time in its culmination.

At this stage, without adverting to the merits of the case, I am of the view that petitioner, who is in custody since 25.10.2019 can be enlarged on bail.

In view of above, petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
