The petitioner herein has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 188 dated 9.7.2019, under Sections 498-A, 304-B, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Kalayat, District Kaithal.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case and he is in custody since 12.7.2019, when he voluntarily surrendered. It is submitted that a reading of Annexure P/2 would reflect that the deceased had gone to the house of the petitioner voluntarily, where they resided having their marriage solemnized but she remained under depression on account of the fact that her parents had broken the engagement and were not happy with the marriage she had entered into voluntarily. The trial is likely to take some time. No useful

purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind bars till the conclusion of the trial. He prays that the petitioner be admitted to regular bail.

Ms. Mahima Yashpal, AAG, Haryana. has contested the bail while submitting that the allegations levelled against the petitioner are of serious nature.

Without going into the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that two material witnesses out of the total 14 have been examined and the trial is likely to take some time to conclude, the present petition is accepted and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
