Admittedly, after registration of the FIR, the police did not find any merit in the case after holding an enquiry and as per enquiry conducted by Addl. Deputy Commissioner of Police, he vide his report (copy Annexure P-10), came to the conclusion that the allegations in the FIR were not found to be true and a cancellation report is required to be prepared in this case. Necessary recommendation in that regard has been made. It being so, the police is likely to file cancellation report in the matter in the Court of Illaqa Magistrate. Therefore, no necessity of quashing the FIR at this stage. However, in case, the Illaqa Magistrate does not agree with the report and directs further investigation, then the petitioner may approach this Court again in accordance with law.
