This is the second petition that has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 0137 dated 29.10.2019, registered under Sections 341, 323, 324, 506, 148, 149 and 425 of the IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on) at Police Station Nangal, District Rupnagar.

The first petition bearing CRM-M-55629-2019 was dismissed as withdrawn on 08.01.2020 by passing the following order:

“After arguing the matter for some time, counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw this petition with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court and the trial Court be directed to decide the regular bail application of the petitioner expeditiously.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

In case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within a period of 01 week from today and apply for regular bail, the trial Court will dispose of the regular bail application of the petitioner within a period of 03 days thereafter.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to reargue the case on the grounds which were available to the petitioner when the first petition was heard and ultimately dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty to petitioner.

In view of the above, finding no ground to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner, this petition is hereby dismissed.
