Through instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. prayer has been made for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in a case arising from FIR No.241, dated 31.10.2019, registered under Sections 376, 506, 34 IPC and 8 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 (POCSO Act), Police Station Beas, District Amritsar (Rural).

Learned counsel for respondent Nos.2 and 3 submits that he has no objection for grant of regular bail to petitioner as compromise has been effected between the parties.

Considering overall facts and circumstances, but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, and in view of compromise effected between the parties, the instant petition is

allowed. Consequently, petitioner Jugraj Singh @ Joga is ordered to be released on bail during pendency of trial, if not required in any other case, on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
