Through this second petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 868 dated 03.11.2019 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC and Section 61 of Punjab Excise Act, 1914, at Police Station Model Town, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case by the police in order to grab money by putting pressure. The petitioner has not been named in the FIR and no role has been attributed to him.

Earlier the first bail petition of the petitioner bearing No. CRM-M-55148-2019 filed on the same ground, was withdrawn by the counsel after arguing for sometime.

There is no change of circumstances, therefore, no case is made out to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.
