Petitioners have filed this petition under Articles 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty at the hands of private respondent No. 4.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the marriage of the petitioners was solemnized on 25.01.2020. Photographs of marriage and Marriage Certificate and are annexed as Annexure P-3 and P-4. Learned counsel has further submitted that the petitioners have moved a representation to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana (Annexure P-5), but no action has been taken thereon so far.

Accordingly, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana is directed to look into the representation (Annexure P-5) moved by the petitioners and if required, necessary protection be provided to them.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.
