Through this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. prayer has been made for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case arising from FIR No.154 dated 24.07.20107, registered under Section 21 of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station Division 7, District Police Commissionerate, Jalandhar, Punjab.

During trial, the petitioner was granted bail. However, he absented on 04.12.20219, at the stage of defence. Thus, the trial court, finding no option, cancelling bail and surety bonds of the petitioner, ordered for securing his presence through non-bailable warrants.

Learned counsel contends that due to noting down wrong date, petitioner could not appear before the trial court on 04.12.2019. His absence is not intentional or willful. He is ready to surrender and face trial.

Having given thoughtful consideration, this Court does not find any ground to grant the benefit of bail to petitioner.

Dismissed. The petitioner is directed to appear before the court below within a week and seek appropriate remedy there.
