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RAJIV SHARMA, J.

The petitioner was convicted and sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for life and to pay fine of ₹ 25,000/- and in default of payment of fine to further undergo rigorous imprisonment for one year under Section 364-A read with Section 120-B IPC. He was also convicted and sentenced to undergo life imprisonment and to pay fine of ₹ 5,000/- and in default of payment of fine to further undergo rigorous imprisonment for six months under Section 120-B IPC.

We have gone through the impugned order dated 5.3.2019 (Annexure P-2). It is not a fit case, where the petitioner can be enlarged on parole.

Petition stands dismissed.
