Challenge is to the order dated 03.10.2016 passed by the learned trial Court.

An application for permission to file the suit as an indigent person was pending before the trial Court. The sole applicant died. The Court followed the procedure as prescribed under Order 22 Rule 4-A of the Code of Civil Procedure. Defendant No.4 filed an application for being transpose as the plaintiff which was rejected by the learned Court vide order dated 01.04.2013, upheld by this Court.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, no ground to interfere in the order passed by the learned trial Court, is made out.

Accordingly, the present revision petition is dismissed.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are disposed of, in view of the abovesaid judgment.
