The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case FIR No.417, dated 27.06.2019, registered under Sections 302, 120-B, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Sector-7, Faridabad, District Faridabad.

2. Heard.

3. The petitioner has remained in detention since 08.07.2019. Admittedly, he was not named in the FIR. He has been implicated on the basis of disclosure statement at the instance of one co-accused, namely, Naresh @ Chand, against whom, the challan has already been submitted, while the investigation against the present petitioner is also complete. It transpires that on the alleged date of

occurrence, the petitioner was already in custody in connection with FIR No.1199 dated 18.10.2017, under Sections 307, 420, 468, 472, 120-B, 34 IPC, at Police Station Central Faridabad, District Faridabad

3. As such, considering the extremely sketchy nature of the implicating material coming forth against the petitioner, his further detention, at this stage, specifically in the present case is not justified. Therefore, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner, namely, Tek Chand, is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
