Defendant-petitioner has filed the present petition against the order passed by learned Trial Court allowing an application under Order 39 Rules 1 and 2 (for grant of temporary injunction) restraining the defendant from changing the nature of the suit property, from raising any further construction thereon or handing over possession thereof to anyone. The order passed by learned Trial Court was affirmed in appeal by the learned first Appellate Court.

It has been noticed that the suit was filed in the year 2014. In State of Punjab, normally such suits are decided within 4-5 years. The stay order granted by the Trial Court has already remained in force for the last 4 years.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, this Court is not inclined to interfere in the orders passed by the Courts. However, learned Trial Court is requested to make a sincere endeavour for disposal of the suit within six months. Needless to observe that prima facie observations made by the Court while disposing of the application under

Order 39 Rules 1 and 2 shall not affect the decision of the suit on merits.
