The State of Haryana has filed present revision petition against order passed by learned Appellate Authority determining mesne profits for the use and occupation of the premises.

Learned counsel for the petitioner fairly submits that the learned Appellate Authority has already dismissed the appeal filed by the State. He submits that against the final judgment of the learned Appellate Authority, revision has been filed.
