Prayer in the present petition is for setting aside the impugned order dated 04.06.2014 vide which the learned trial Court has dismissed the application of the petitioner for production of samples drawn by the Court of Ms. Geeta Rani, Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Jalandhar.

As per the present petition, during prosecution evidence two witnesses ASI and Inspector, PW-6 and PW-7 respectively, have disclosed the names of two different Magistrates and two different dates of drawing of samples.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner contends that he will be satisfied, in case liberty is given to recall the witnesses i.e. PW-6 and PW-7 and in case the petitioner moves an application the same may be considered by the Court below, sympathetically.

In view of the contentions so raise by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with the directions in case any application to that effect is moved by the petitioner, the trial Court would consider the same and will decide as per law.
