The grievance of the petitioner, a resident of Village Korwa Khurd, Tehsil Shahzadpur, District Ambala, is that the authorities are not taking appropriate action against the former Sarpanch of the village, the seventh respondent herein, despite the fact that an enquiry was initiated against him as long back as in the year 2009.

The petitioner submitted representation dated 18.07.2019 (Annexure P-2) in this regard to the Deputy Commissioner, Ambala, the second respondent herein. His complaint presently is that the same did not evoke any effective response from the authorities.

As this Court does not propose to go into the merits of the allegations levelled by the petitioner against the former Sarpanch, there is no necessity to put him on notice or afford him an opportunity of hearing at this stage. It is for the second respondent to take an informed decision upon the petitioner's representation in the first instance and take appropriate

action thereon, if warranted.

The writ petition is accordingly disposed of directing the Deputy Commissioner, Ambala, the second respondent, to consider the petitioner's representation dated 18.07.2019 (Annexure P-2) on its own merits and in accordance with law and take necessary action thereon, if warranted, as per due procedure. This exercise shall be completed expeditiously and in any event, not later than six weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
