Mr. Amit Jain, learned counsel for the petitioner, would fairly inform this Court that he is not in a position to contact the petitioner.

This writ petition was filed assailing a Notification of the year 1995, whereby Municipal Limits were extended over a part of Village Kanech which, in consequence, stood excluded from the Gram Panchayat. No interim orders were granted in this writ petition interdicting the process that had been initiated. That being so, if the petitioner Gram Panchayat presently has no interest in pursuing this writ petition, there is no purpose served in considering the issue on merits

As the learned counsel states that the petitioner is not in contact, the writ petition is dismissed for non-prosecution leaving it open to the petitioner to seek revival, if any cause for grievance still survives.
