This petition has been filed, praying for a direction to the respondent authorities to clean garbage and remove the dustbins placed in front of Kasturba Gandhi School, Ambala City.

It is alleged that the civic authorities concerned, which are required to take up the issue of removal and disposal of garbage by adopting door to door collection method, are not doing so, and on the contrary, garbage is being dumped in front of the School concerned, which is making it difficult for the residents to live in a healthy and clean environment. The petitioner submits that he has filed a representation (Annexure P-2) before the Municipal Corporation, Ambala City, but till date no action has been taken. And, he had even moved the Deputy Commissioner, Ambala, vide representation (Annexure P-3), praying for necessary action, but to no avail. Hence this petition.

This Court has asked the learned Additional Advocate General, appearing for the State of Haryana, to seek instructions from the authorities concerned.

On instructions, it is submitted that the authorities have taken immediate steps to remove garbage from the area concerned, acting on the representation of the petitioner. Learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, on instructions received telephonically from the Secretary, Municipal Corporation, Ambala City, submits that Municipal Corporation, Ambala City, has undertaken to ensure that periodical garbage removal would be done by the authorities and the grievance of the petitioner would be redressed as early as possible.

In view of the aforesaid undertaking and the facts that have been brought before this Court by the learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, the petition is disposed of, granting liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondent authorities in case so requires in future. It goes without saying that if the petitioner does so, the authorities shall consider his concerns and take suitable measures, if required, in accordance with law.
