Through this petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner has prayed for issuance of direction to release the detenues, who are in illegal detention of the private respondents.

This petition is a blackmailing device. Petitioner instead of filing the instant petition could seek remedy under Section 97 Cr.P.C., but intentionally came to this Court to create chaos and fear in the locality.

Dismissed.

In case, the petitioner would file any such type of petition in future in the court, it would be dealt with suitably including sending him behind bars.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the criminal writ petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
