RAMENDRA JAIN, J. (Oral)

Through instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. prayer has been made for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in a case arising from FIR No.485 dated 25.11.2018, registered under Sections 148, 149, 307, 323, 427, 452, 506 IPC (Section 302 IPC added later) and 25, 54 of the Arms Act, at Police Station KUK, District Kurukshetra.

Learned counsel for the petitioners *inter alia* contends that three star witnesses of prosecution have turned hostile. Petitioners are in custody since 01.12.2018.

Learned State counsel has not been able to controvert the aforesaid submissions. However, he vehemently opposed the grant of regular bail to the petitioners.

Considering overall facts and circumstances, but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is

allowed. Consequently, petitioners are ordered to be released on bail during pendency of trial, if not required in any other case, on their furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
