RAJ MOHAN SINGH, J.

This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C.
for grant of regular bail in case bearing FIR No.288 dated
10.9.2019 registered under Sections 323/ 307/ 506/ 34 IPC at
Police Station Division No.8 District Ludhiana.

As per prosecution case, petitioner is son of Sheetla
Parshad, whose shop was recommended by Ved Parkash to the
injured and his brother Raj Kumar for purchasing cold drink etc.
As per the allegations, Ved Parkash inflicted blow with screw
driver on the head of Deepak Kumar. Co-accused Arjan gave
stick blows to the complainant, whereas, Karan caught hold of
Deepak Kumar. Sheetla Parshad allegedly exhorted that the

accused party be not left.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sukhjinder Singh, states that co-accused Arjan is still at large. The alleged role attributed to the petitioner is of catching hold of Deepak Kumar.

Petitioner is in custody since 10.9.2019. Challan has been presented.

At this stage, without meaning anything on the merits of the case, it would be just and appropriate to grant regular bail to the petitioner.

In view of above, this petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail, subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
