Mr. B.S.Jaswal, Advocate has filed vakalatnama on behalf of complainant of his own, though he has not been impleaded as a party-respondent. Same is taken on record. Be tagged at appropriate place.

Through this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. prayer has been made for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in cross case bearing DDR No.29 dated 22.11.2019, registered under Sections 323, 325, 326, 148, 149 IPC, at Police Station Gharinda, District Amritsar Rural in FIR No.186 dated 12.11.2019, registered under Sections 323, 324, 427, 452, 148, 149 IPC, at aforesaid police station.

According to prosecution, petitioner caused two spade

blows on the head of injured Amarjit Kaur, which have been declared grievous in nature.

Learned counsel for complainant has pointed out that, initially on the day of incident i.e. 12.11.2019, injured Amarjit Kaur was admitted in CHC, Lopoke where she remained admitted upto 15.11.2019. Thereafter, on 15.11.2019, she was shifted to GND Hospital, Amritsar where she remained admitted upto 19.11.2019. Then, she was admitted in K.D.hospital where a major operation was conducted, incurring around Rs.1,00,000/- on her medical treatment. On 18.12.2019, injured was again admitted in said K.D.Hospital and she remained there upto 24.12.2019.

Considering the serious injury, caused by petitioner to injured Amarjit Kaur, petitioner does not deserve any concession of anticipatory bail.

Dismissed.
