(1) Notice of motion. Ms. Palika Monga, DAG Haryana accepts notice. Copy supplied. In view of the nature of order which this Court proposes to pass, there is no necessity to call upon the respondents to file their reply, at this stage.

(2) The present writ petition has been filed by petitioner Ashok Kumar, *inter alia*, with a prayer for directing the respondents to consider his claim as mentioned in the representation dated 05.11.2019 (P9), a copy of which has been appended as Annexure P9.

(3) Learned counsel submits that in this writ petition as well as in the representation, the demand/prayer made is that the competent authority to consider and give appointment to the petitioner to the post of Constable (Male) Haryana Police. He further submits that the petitioner has *prima facie* good case as he was successful in the written test and physical standard test. The petitioner was also released on probation in appeal in a case registered against him under the Information Technology Act and as such, no disqualification can be attached.

(4) Having heard learned counsel for the parties, this Court deems it appropriate to dispose of the writ petition, without commenting upon the

merits of the case, by directing the competent authority to consider and decide the petitioner's claim as raised in his representation (P9) within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
