This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking direction to respondents No.1 to 4 to conduct fair and impartial investigation in case bearing FIR No.2 dated 4.1.2020, registered under Sections 323, 341, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Bhikhi, District Mansa and for adding offence under sections 307, 452, 326 and 354 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the aforesaid FIR was registered on 4.1.2020, but no further action has been taken nor her representation dated 16.01.2020 (Annexure P-3) has been decided. He further states that even after lodging of FIR against respondents No.5 to 9 and filing of the representation, the accused are threatening the petitioner and her mother-in-law and are compelling her to compromise the matter.

In view of the above, without going into the merit of the present case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the

Senior Superintendent of Police, Mansa, to look into the matter, take necessary action and decide the representation dated 16.01.2020 (Annexure P-3) as per law expeditiously, preferably within one month.
